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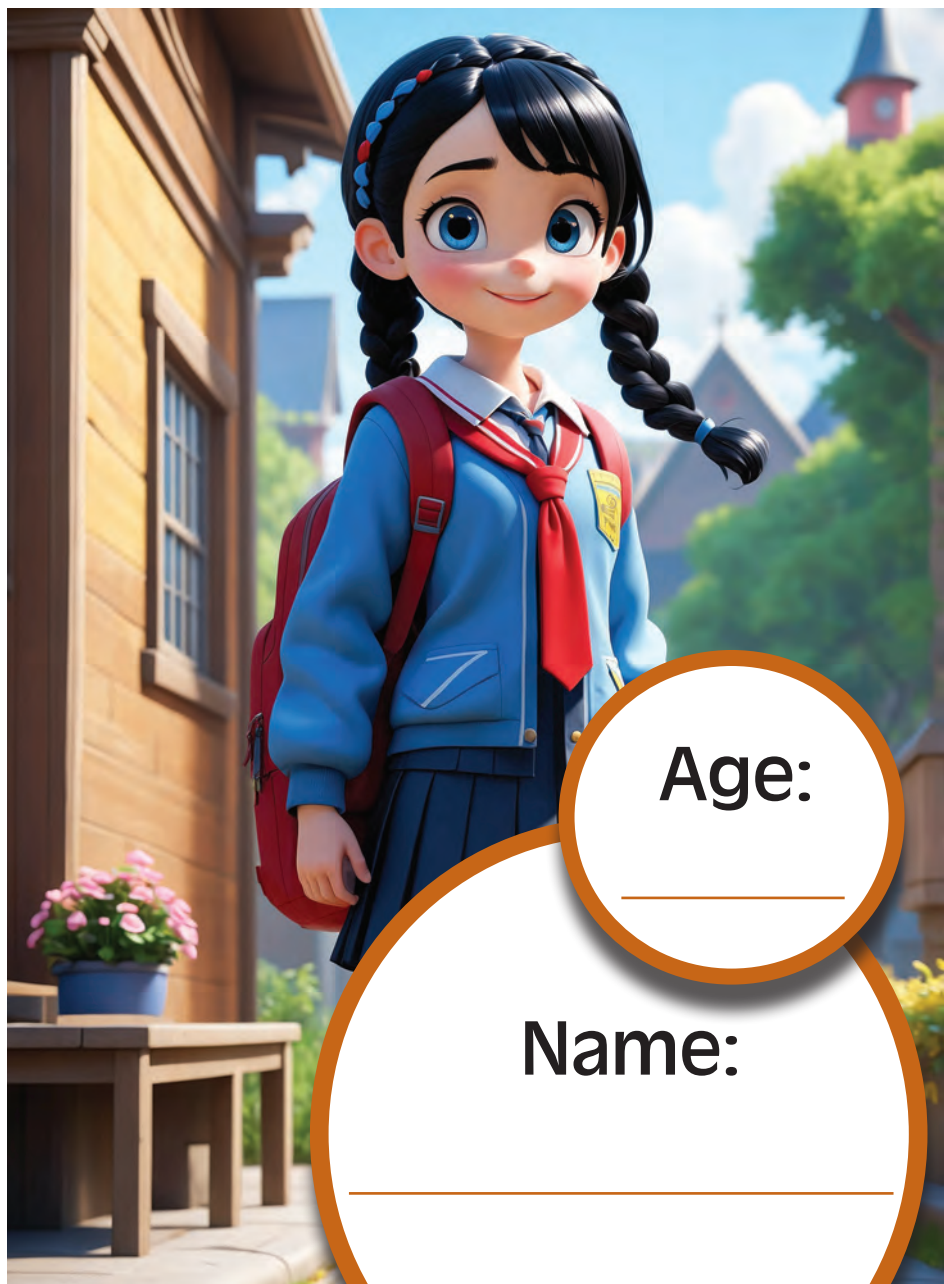
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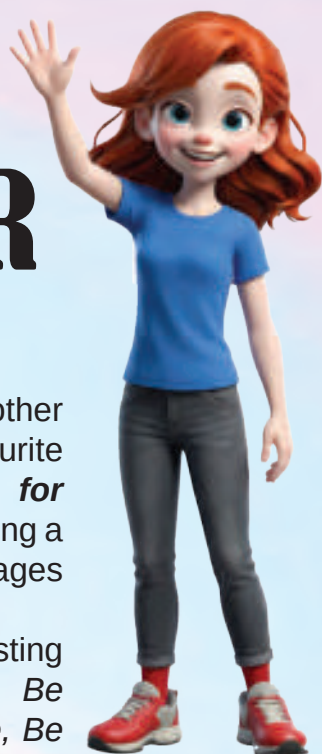

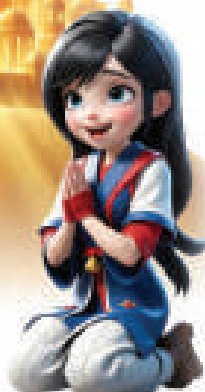
And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men

The Bible tells us that Samuel became very upset with the children of Israel when they asked for a king (1 Samuel 8:4–7). But God corrected Samuel. The people *"...have not rejected you,"* the Lord said, *"...they have rejected Me."* If anyone was to be upset, it was the Lord, not Samuel.

God helped Samuel understand not to take things personally. In the same way, when someone hurts your feelings, talk to the Lord about it instead of responding in anger. Ask yourself, "Will my reaction please the Lord?" When you live to please the Lord, your heart will stay peaceful at all times.

4 STEPS TO DOING SOUL WINNING WELL

These are 4 steps given to us by our Man of God through the Holy Spirit to help us do soul winning the right way:

STEP 1: STAY FULL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT—

Romans 12:11

To be filled with the Spirit means to be full of His power, joy, and strength at all times. Even though you've received the Holy Spirit, you must keep filling yourself with Him every day. This is the first and most important step.

When you're full of the Spirit, you'll be bold, joyful, and ready to speak. You won't struggle to find words; God will help you speak wisely.

STEP 2: UNDERSTAND THE GOSPEL CLEARLY—

2 Timothy 2:15

The Gospel is the good news that Jesus died for our sins and gave us new life through His resurrection.

The Bible teaches us to study so we can understand God's Word well. If you don't understand it clearly, it'll be difficult to explain it properly to others.

You can grow by studying your Bible, listening in church, and writing down what you learn. The better you understand the Gospel, the easier it'll be to share it.

STEP 3: TEACH THE GOSPEL WELL—

Matthew 28:19-20

Now that you understand the Gospel, the next step is to teach it to others.

Jesus told us to teach others, not just speak to them. There is a difference between preaching and teaching. Preaching is announcing what Jesus has done.

Teaching is making it clear so people truly understand. When you teach the Gospel simply and clearly, people can receive it with joy.

STEP 4: LEAD THEM TO RECEIVE JESUS—

Romans 10:9-10

After teaching the Gospel, you must lead them to receive Jesus. The Bible shows that salvation comes by believing in the heart and speaking with the mouth.

Help them say a simple prayer of faith. Don't stop at talking—lead them into salvation. This is the main purpose of evangelism.

CONCLUSION

If you carefully follow these four steps, you will do God's work well and help many people come to know Jesus and grow in Him.
